
# STUDENT-CENTRIC DESIGN



Full Production of Inspire Dorm Line Begins



Through a series of sketches, models, and presentations, the students refined their designs and produced mock-ups for their final presentations. At the conclusion, five products were selected as Design Choice Winners, which came with monetary awards. The designs from the team of Sarah Hashiguchi and Amanda Kibbel were selected for production in their entirety.

Manufactured at the Two Rivers Correctional Institution, the five pieces now known as the Inspire Dorm Line took shape and made the trek to NYC for the International Contemporary Furniture Fair.
